# WORKSHOPS AT HIGH GOSFORTH PARK GOLF CLUB, GOSFORTH PARK

### HOW TO GET THERE

High Gosforth Park Golf Club is in Gosforth Park, situated near to the main stands of Newcastle Racecourse. Newcastle Racecourse is just off the A1 north of Newcastle. Follow the signs to the racecourse. Once you are in Gosforth Park near the main stand, look for the big green sign stating **Car Park B** and then drive down the lane next to it and the golf club car park will be straight in front of you. The workshop is held in the meeting room upstairs and the staff will happily direct you. The postcode for the golf club is **NE3 5HQ - although this will take you to the general area and not directly to the golf club.**

## WHAT TO BRING ON PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOPS & PHOTO WALKS

- You will need your camera. Ensure it has fresh/fully charged batteries and a spare battery is recommended.
- You may wish to bring the manual if you have one.
- A camera bag is useful for protecting your camera and equipment when outdoors, and a transparent plastic bag and some sticky tape make a good, temporary waterproof cover for your camera and an umbrella will protect your equipment and you in wet weather. •
- Bring a tripod (full height) if you are attending a Part 2 Workshop.
- Dress in warm, comfortable clothing for outdoor sessions. A waterproof/ windproof top will be useful. Comfortable but strong footwear is advised for photographing outdoors, plus a garden kneeler or similar for getting low for some photos.
- In addition, it can be quite muddy while out taking photographs, please bring a pair of trainers or indoor boots or shoes to travel home in.
