Your photography course will run from **10am to 4 pm.** Please arrive 15 minutes before your workshop is due to start. Please remember to bring your Tutor's mobile number to call them in the event of any difficulties on the day.

HOW TO GET THERE – Please ensure you check your confirmation email for the correct course venue the first day of the wedding course may be held at the Imperial Hotel in Russell Square, and the second day at the Church. If a Masterclass is held at a different location in London it will be on the course subtitle. You will be emailed the definite addresses in your reminder email a few days before the course so please read this email in case there have been any changes!

WEDDING PHOTOGRAPHY COURSES AT ST GEORGE'S CHURCH IN BLOOMSBURY: St. George's Church, 7 Little Russell Street, London, WC1A 2HR.

St George's Bloomsbury is located on Bloomsbury Way next door to the Bloomsbury Thistle Hotel. (WC1A 2HR), two minutes walk from the British Museum. Going Digital Wedding Photography courses are held in the Upper Vestry Hall. Access to the Upper Vestry Hall is from 6/7 Little Russell Street (at the rear of the Church) where there is a gate and a buzzer/intercom to the office. Please come to the rear and use the clearly marked buzzer. The nearest tube stations are Tottenham Court Road (Central and Northern Lines), Holborn (Piccadilly Line) and Russell Square (Piccadilly Line). The following buses (eastbound) stop directly outside the church: 1, 8, 19, 25, 38, 55, 98, 242.

REFRESHMENTS

Coffee, tea and water are usually available all day at our courses. For lunch you can either bring a packed lunch or eat in a nearby cafe/restaurant/pub.

WHAT TO BRING ON PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOPS:

- You will need your camera. Ensure it has fresh/fully charged batteries and a spare battery is recommended.
- It is useful to bring your camera instruction manual if you have one.
- Bring SLR lenses, hot-shoe mounted flashes or other accessories, and please bring the instruction manuals for flashes too.

- Memory card it is essential that you start the day with an empty, preferably newly formatted, memory card. We will use card readers to transfer your images to our computers, but in the event that we are not able to do this successfully, please bring your camera to computer data cable too.
- A full set of PDF course notes will be emailed to you after the course so you may like to bring a pen and paper to make a note or two of your own.
- A camera bag is useful for protecting your camera and equipment when outdoors, and a transparent plastic bag and rubber band make a good, temporary waterproof cover for your camera and an umbrella will protect your equipment and you in wet weather.
- A tripod (full height) if you have one is essential for landscape, Low-Light & Fill-In Flash, Wedding, and Water & Movement workshops). You do not need a tripod for Explore 1.
- Dress in warm, comfortable clothing for outdoor sessions. A waterproof/ windproof top will be useful.
